OOTOTOWN SOME HISTORY + HOT SPOT&NEWS



OOTOTOWN TERRITORY INITIALLY PROSPERED AS ONE OF THE LARGE MANORS BELONGING TO USA SHRINE, USA-MIKURU TEMPLE AND MT. HIKO IN THE MEDIEVAL TIMES OF JAPAN. LATER, DURING THE AGE OF CIVIL WARS, THIS AREA CHANGED HANDS BETWEEN THE O'YOSHIS AND THE O'UCHIS FREQUENTLY WHO RULED THERE BY TURNS. DURING THIS TIME, THIS AREA WAS OFTEN EXPOSED TO FIRES OF WAR UNTIL IT BECAME UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE MORIS, ONE OF THE MAJOR SUBORDINATES OF HIDEYOSHI TOYOTOMI WHO FULLY CONQUERED KYUSHU ISLAND. AFTER THE BATTLE OF SEKIGAHARA, IN WHICH THE MORIS AND OTHER WESTERN LORDS WERE DEFEATED, THE MORIS LOST ITS O'TO TERRITORY. THEN, O'TO TERRITORY BECAME CONTROLLED BY THE HOSOKAWAS AND THEN THE OGASAWARAS IN EDO ERA. DURING EDO PERIOD, O'TO TERRITORY WAS DIVIDED INTO TWO AREAS: SOYEDA DISTRICT AND ITA DISTRICT FOR EASIER CONTROL. SOON AFTER THE MEIJI RESTORATION, O'TO TERRITORY WAS REORGANIZED WITH SEVERAL MERGES OF ITS SMALL VILLAGES. IN MAY OF 1887, THE THEN SEVEN VILLAGES AND THREE VILLAGES FROM THE AREAS WERE MERGED INTO DAIGYOJI VILLAGE AND IMATOBARU VILLAGE, WHICH FOLLOWED THE LARGE MERGE OF THE TWO VILLAGES IN MAY, 1889 AND O'TO VILLAGE WAS BORN. THEN, AFTER THE EXECUTION OF THE NEWLY-RULED TOWN ADMINISTRATION IN JANUARY, 1948, O'TO VILLAGE BECAME THE CURRENT FORM OF O'TO TOWN. DIRECTED, KOSU KOUKI, NAGAHARA TAISHIN
